### **Big Picture**

- Kansas population is:
  - Growing slower than the U.S. as a whole
  - Increasingly aging
  - Concentrating in urban areas
  - Becoming increasingly diverse


### **Population Growth**

- Between 1960 and 2016:
  - ▶ U.S. population grew 80.2%
  - Kansas population grew 33.4%
- Rural vs. Urban (1960 2016)
  - Urban counties: 80.8%
  - Semi-urban counties: 24.2
  - Rural counties: 22.2%
  - Frontier counties: 41.1%


Between 2000 and 2016, 82 of 105 counties experienced a population loss.

### Population Growth 2000 - 2016

- Non-Hispanic White population in Kansas: 0.4%
- Non-Hispanic White population in U.S. 2%
- Communities of color in Kansas: 52.
- Communities of color in U.S.: 44.8 6


All population growth in Kansas between 2000 and 2016 was among communities of color.

### Population Change by Race/Ethnicity 2000-2016




## County Population Change by Race/Ethnicity 2000-2016


- Non-Hispanic White population
  - Urban counties: 7.2%
  - Semi-urban counties: 1.79
  - Offset by population decreases in rural and frontier counties
    - Resulting in net decrease of 0.3
- Communities of color
  - Urban counties: 56.19
  - Semi-urban counties: 51
  - Densely settled rural counties: 36.2 6
  - Rural counties: 63.89
  - ► Frontier counties: 63.3%



### Population % Change by Race/Ethnicity/County 2000-2016




### Total Population Change by County 2000-2016




# Non-Hispanic White Population Change by County 2000-2016

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
